NOTIFICATION

Whereas in Notification No. SWD 5 SBR 76 dated: 26.3.76 provisions of the Karnataka Prohibition of Beggary Act, 1975 were brought into force in the areas comprised in the Corporations of the City of Bangalore and City of Hubli-Dharwad and in the Municipalities of Mysore, Mangalore, Belgaum, Gulbarga, Bellary, Davanagere, Bijapur and Shimoga with effect from 1.4.1976;

Whereas in Notification No. SWD 5 SBR 76 dated 30th August, 1976, the Government appointed the first day of September 1976 as the date from which beggary cess shall be levied;

And whereas in Notification No. SWD 15 SBR 97 dated: 28.8.97, the Government has further extended the provisions of the Karnataka Prohibition of Beggary Act, 1975 to the rest of the areas of the State with immediate effect.

Now, Therefore, in exercise of powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 31 of the Karnataka Prohibition of Beggary Act, 1975 (Karnataka Act 27 of 1975), the Government of Karnataka hereby appoints 1st day of April 2000, as the date from which the beggary cess shall be levied in the rest of the areas of the State where the provisions of the said Act have been brought into force by the Notification No. SWD 15 SBR 97 dated: 28.8.1997.
